A Quick Guide to Finding Your SAM UEI and Expiration Date

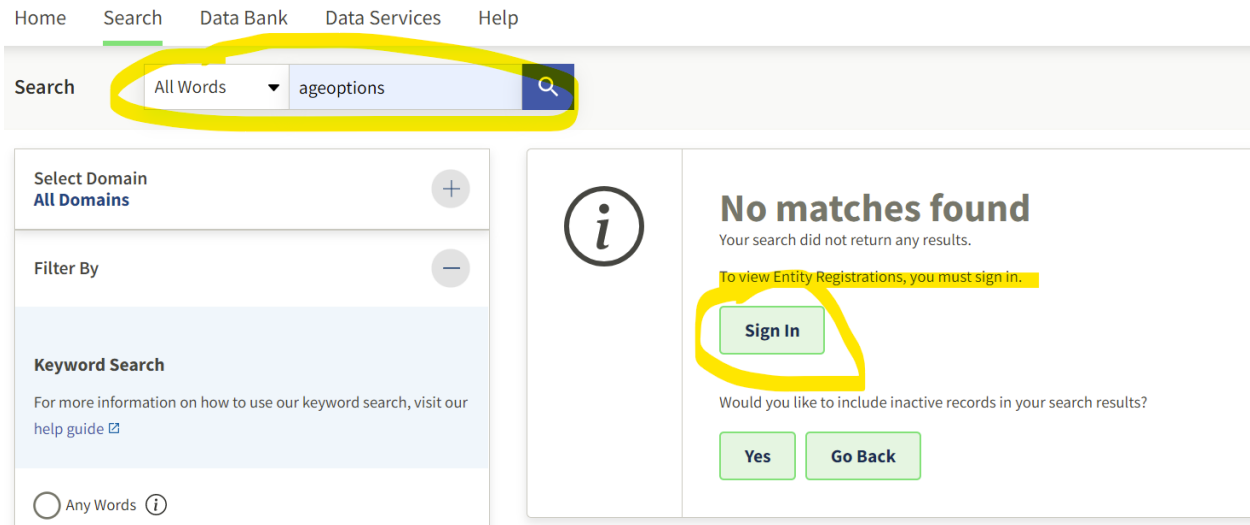
SAM Unique Entity ID (UEI) is new. If you or someone in your agency, logs into your SAM.gov account, you should be able to find it.

Alternatively, anyone with a Login.gov account can search SAM.gov for an entity. Here's how to do that:

- Visit www.sam.gov
- Go to "Search"



- From the Search page, type in the name of your agency in the search bar and hit Enter
- You'll likely be prompted to sign-in to view entities. Click "Sign In"



- Accept website terms if prompted
- You'll be directed to a Login.gov page. SAM.gov is using Login.gov to securely allow access. You may already have a Login.gov account. If not, it's easy to create one. Or check the Forged Your Password? Link



- Once signed in, you'll see your search.
- You may need to try a few search terms to find your SAM entry
- Once you find your agency, you'll see that you can find your:
 - SAM Unique Entity ID (UEI)
 - Your SAM Expiration Date
 - And even your DUNS number (if needed)
