



Connecting Older Adults with Community-based Resources and Options

AgeOptions is a nonprofit organization connecting adults aged 60 and over and those who care about them with resources and services that allow them to live their lives to the fullest while remaining in their homes and communities for as long as they are able. AgeOptions is the Area Agency on Aging of suburban Cook County. We serve a diverse population of 602,017 older adults in 130 communities within 30 townships.

Services provided through AgeOptions and partner agencies:

- **Information and Assistance** is provided by trained specialists who are available to answer questions about social services, housing, transportation, health and medication insurance, and benefits and resources for older adults and people with disabilities
- **Housing Assistance** offers local assistance & resources to live affordably and safely in your home
- **Benefits Access** provides help checking eligibility and applying for prescription assistance, Medicare, energy discounts, property tax programs, SNAP and more
- **Nutritional Meals** are available at community dining programs or can be delivered to your home
- **Chore/Housekeeping** provides help in maintaining the cleanliness and functionality of your home
- **Caregiver Support** offers help to those caring for a loved one, including counseling, education, in-home and out-of-home respite care, support groups and other services for older adults, those with Alzheimer's or related disorders, and relatives raising children
- **Adult Protective Services** provide community education and intervention aimed at eliminating abuse, neglect, and exploitation of older adults and people with disabilities over 18 years of age
- **Illinois Pathways to Health** provides workshops for participants to learn skills to better manage their chronic conditions or pain, skills to prevent falls and strategies for self-care for caregivers. Find workshops near you at www.ilpathwaystohealth.org.
- **SMP** empowers beneficiaries in Illinois to prevent, detect and report healthcare fraud. (800)699-9043
- **Cultural Services and Supports**, provided by specific ethnic organizations, include referrals, translation & other services that are culturally appropriate to limited English proficient persons
